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Swearing In of Glendora Police Chief Lisa Rosales

GLENDORA - Monday February 6, 2017 was an important day for Glendora and also for the new Chief of Police. The second floor of the Glendora Public Library, known as the Bidwell Forum was filled to capacity with police personnel, Glendorans, friends and family. Chief Lisa Rosales was sworn in as Glendora's Police Chief. There were Police Chiefs from at least seven surrounding cities at the occasion, including Glendale's Police Chief Rob Castro, who was previously a Police Chief of Glendora.

The Honor Guard of the Glendora Police Department marched into the hall, wearing their spic and span, "dress" uniforms and stood at attention on either side of the lectern. Police Chaplain Reverend Karen Davis gave the Invocation. City Manager, Chris Jeffers coordinated the event. He explained how the new Chief was chosen out of over thirty candidates and how the choice was unanimously ratified by the five members of the Glendora City Council. Assemblyman Chris Holden Announces Legislation to Stop 710 Freeway Tunnel

SOUTH PASADENA – Assemblyman Chris Holden and a coalition of city councilmembers, community leaders, and non-profit organizations gathered outside Mission Street Metro Station to announce the introduction of Assembly Bill 287. AB 287 finds a solution to the State Route 710 corridor gap between the I-10 and I-210 freeways and prohibits the construction of a freeway tunnel.

“With billions of state dollars at stake and no hard evidence pointing to traffic relief for the San Gabriel Valley, it is clear that building a freeway tunnel is not a prudent option,” said Assemblyman Chris Holden. “In light of California’s landmark climate legislation that mandates the rapid reduction of our greenhouse gas emissions, makes clear that the I-710 North tunnel project is a misguided and obsolete solution.”

“Residents in El Sereno and the West San Gabriel Valley want more options, more transportation, less congestion and less

smog,” said Damon Nagami, director of the Natural Resources Defense Council’s (NRDC) Southern California Ecosystems Project. “Instead of spending billions on a flawed project that will put more cars on the road and increase pollution, we should invest in solutions that would actually improve people’s transportation options while also helping the environment.”

Last year, the proposed multi-billion dollar 710 Tunnel Project made the top 12 list of most wasteful highway expansion projects across the country in a report by the California Public Interest Research Group (CALPIRG) Education Fund.

“Our research tells us that millennials want to live, work, and thrive in walkable, sustainable neighborhoods,” said Will Eley, Policy Advocate for CALPIRG. “They demand transportation options, and another car-centric road or tunnel is just more of the same. A tunnel project would not only be costly for Californians in the short term, but would exacerbate pollution and traffic for

decades to come.”

Assembly Bill 287 creates the I-710 Gap Corridor Transit Zone Advisory Committee with representation from Alhambra, Los Angeles, Pasadena, South Pasadena, the Department of Transportation, the Metropolitan Transportation Authority, and Members of the Legislature representing corridor gap. The committee will review a wide range of traffic calming, green space and mass transit options for the 6.2 mile gap and recommend a viable, community supported solution to the Department of Transportation. The bill specifically prohibits the Department of Transportation from constructing a freeway tunnel between the I-210 and I-10 freeways.

“As our state and cities integrate smart growth, new technologies and transit oriented development into our evolving transportation infrastructure, large freeway projects like the State Route 710 Tunnel are no longer necessary or environmentally sustainable,” said Holden.

Suspect Arrested For Attempted Murder, Attempted Arson, Burglary and Resisting Arrest

SAN GABRIEL - On February 8 at approximately 12:23am, The San Gabriel Police Department received a call for help from inside a residence in the 100 block of E. Grand Ave. in the City of San Gabriel. When officers arrived on scene, they discovered at least two adult male subjects with known gang ties involved in a physical struggle. One of the adult male subjects was found by officers to be bleeding from multiple lacerations on his head and back. Immediately after separating the subjects, 40 year-old San Gabriel resident, Luis Anchondo, attempted to flee the scene. A short foot pursuit by police of Anchondo ensued and Anchondo was captured a short time later without incident.

During their initial investiga-

tion, police determined that the incident began when Anchondo had forcibly removed a window of the residence to enter the home. Once inside the residence, Anchondo began pouring gasoline from a gas container he had in his possession on the interior floor of the residence in an apparent attempt to set fire to the home. The victim confronted Anchondo at this time and a physical altercation ensued between both males. During the struggle, Anchondo used a meat cleaver to strike the victim multiple times on the head and back. A witness inside the home subsequently called the police who later arrested Anchondo for burglary, attempted murder, and attempted arson. The 40 year-old victim of the assault was transported to a

nearby hospital for treatment of his injuries.

The San Gabriel Fire Department’s Arson Investigator and Police Detectives are collaboratively investigating this incident. At this time, the house has been deemed safe and the residents have been allowed to occupy the home.

Anchondo is currently being held at Alhambra Jail in lieu of \$1,000,000 bail pending arraignment scheduled for Friday, February 10, 2017 at Alhambra Superior Court.

Irwindale Burglary Suspect Outstanding, Two Others Arrested

IRWINDALE - Irwindale Police responded to a burglary in progress around 4:00 a.m. on Sunday morning Feb. 12 at Pita To Go and the Sushi Irwindale restaurants in the 15600 block of Arrow Highway.

As soon as the police showed up, three men took off in a car. A two mile pursuit ended when the suspects stopped their car in Covina and fled in all directions.

Backup was called and help from Azusa, Baldwin Park, Covina and West Covina police arrived and a perimeter was set up. Police found one suspect around 8 a.m. hiding in a yard and the other was arrested

around 9 a.m. as he simply started walking down the street. The third suspect is still outstanding.

Justin Chambers, 20, who has a previous criminal record, had his bail set at \$102,125.00 and Maurice Wright, 22, also

with an extensive record. Bail was set at \$50,000. Both are from Cerritos. The third suspect that is outstanding is a male, early 20’s, around 5’10”, 175 lbs. wearing dark clothes. He may be armed and dangerous.

Covina Officer Almost Shot by Suspect

COVINA - Covina police responded around Thursday, Feb. 9 around 7:30 p.m., to Bert’s Mega Mall, at N Azusa Ave. in Covina.


They were responding to a call where a man, identified as Jorge Valenzuela, 25 years old, was attempting to buy a dirt bike with a false ID.

When officers arrived, Valenzuela ran from the store. Officers gave chase and during the chase, Valenzuela was seen reaching into his waist band as if he had a gun. The suspect did in fact have a gun and turned to shoot the officer behind him. Instead of using deadly force, as this would have certainly been justified to do so, the officer

used a Taser Gun which took down the suspect. However, the suspect still struggled with police and the officers were able to wrestle the weapon away from him.

The suspect was taken to a hospital for possible injuries caused by the Taser.

Valenzuela is a convicted felon and was out on bond and also had an ankle monitoring bracelet as part of his parole for a robbery. His bail set at \$135,000, that is for one charge and then a no bail for the following: charged for the attempted murder of a police officer. Other charges: identity theft, being a felon in possession of a firearm, assault on an officer using a firearm and evading.

Upcoming Event?
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FOMC Content With Rates Where They Are

The FOMC not only left rates unchanged (as expected) at its first 2017 meeting on Feb 1, it gave no indication when the next rate hike might come.

>There were no dissents, which might reflect satisfaction that interest rates are in the right place after December's hike or might reflect the rotation of the committee. All 2016 dissenters are nonvoters this year.

>The Fed noted the improvement in both business and consumer sentiment since the December meeting. But household spending growth is moderate and business fixed investment appears soft. Presumably, the FOMC is content to wait and see if stronger expectations translate into a stronger reality.

>The statement offered few clues to when rates might rise again.

The lack of surprises in last week's FOMC statement suggests the Fed is in no hurry to raise rates. It could make sense for the Fed to hike in March if their first priority were to raise rates three times, as suggested by the December forecast. But the data feeding the Fed's policy guides does not yet support a hike, nor apparently does it support a strong signal concerning the next meeting. Their statement is a reminder the Fed's top priority is getting policy right, not validating its forecast.

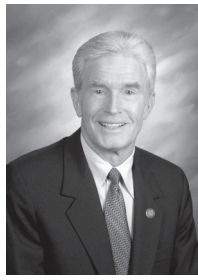
TEPID EMPLOYMENT REPORT DESPITE SOLID JOBS GAIN

Nonfarm payrolls grew 227k in January. December was revised up 1k to 157k and November was revised down 40k to 164k. The unemployment rate rose from 4.7% to 4.8%.

The big ADP gain earlier in the week prepared Wall Street for a

200-250k number. The Fed's two chief concerns (earnings growth and the unemployment rate) deteriorated, validating the FOMC's message earlier: There is no urgency to hike rates again soon.

The fourth quarter's 148k average job growth was the weakest since the 90k average in the second quarter of 2012. January's rebound is hopefully the first of several above-trend gains. Last year's Presidential election was at the top of risk lists all year. We've seen it again and again since the financial crisis. Uncertainty stops corporate decision making, including hiring, for a month or two and then it all comes back with a bang. Why should the election of a president favored by most businesses be any different?

OVER REGULATION LEADSTO PARALYSIS

Regulation is always well-intentioned. Someone was hurt and rules were imposed to prevent the same fate from happening to others. But these rules always impose costs. Good regulation prevents harm at minimal cost. Bad regulation is usually very costly and achieves questionable results. Dodd-Frank is massive in scope and was written hastily. No one should be surprised there are parts that dramatically increased costs while providing only mod-

est protection.

Unfortunately coverage of Trump's executive order reversing the fiduciary rule and pruning around the edges of Dodd-Frank - described by National Economic Council Director Gary Cohn as a "table setter for a bunch of stuff that is coming" - mostly follows the journalistic trope ignoring costs and assuming regulation is the only guard protecting consumers from greedy businesses.

Regulation is a \$2trillion+ annual burden on the economy. According to the National Association of Manufacturers, the average US Company paid \$233k annually in compliance costs in 2012. That was 21% of payroll. Small manufacturers with fewer than 50 employees paid \$34,671 per employee, three times the national average. Since 2012, a blizzard of additional rules were imposed. Bank regulation since the financial crisis reduced productivity, and therefore potential GDP growth, by a full percentage point or more, according to work by Morgan Stanley economists. It is a mistake to ignore regulatory costs.

The WSJ ran an article recently about how President's since Jimmy Carter have struggled to reduce red tape. It is really, really hard, they wrote. Indeed, they described the fiduciary rule in terms of what it was intended to accomplish - not what it actually did - leaving the President looking like a villain for reversing it even though it did not work as intended. No wonder it's hard.

Your Money - Ask Julia

My medical expenses didn't quite add up to the allowable percentage of my adjusted gross income, so I did not get the medical deduction on my tax return. Is there anything else that counts as medical expenses?

Yes, the IRS allows you to count under medical expenses: round-trip travel expenses for medical treatments, purchase of things that you needed but insurance didn't cover, the expense of some quit-smoking and weight-loss programs, insurance premium payments paid with after-tax money, special-needs expenses (adding ramps, widening doors, etc.), and long-term care insurance premiums.

When we retire, we will sell our first home and move into our second home. Have capital gains taxes changed, or are we okay?

On your primary residence, the capital gains tax exemption did not change. It's still \$250,000 (single), or \$500,000 (married).

Can I do a 1035 exchange from an annuity into a paid-up life insurance policy?

The rule is that an annuity cannot be 1035 exchanged into a life insurance policy. Annuities can be 1035 exchanged into another annuity. A life insurance policy can be 1035 exchanged to another life insurance, or into an annuity. You might be pleased to learn how annuities nowadays have close similarities to life insurance, but with living benefits, too.

My banker keeps calling me to schedule an appointment to discuss moving my money from a 7-year annuity that I bought in 2013. Is that something I should consider? Oh, by the way, I'm in my late 60's and semi-retired.

Take a close look at what you already have vs. what your banker is recommending. Most annuities carry a surrender fee, comparable to an early withdrawal penalty. Your annuity policy will clearly show this as something like: 1st Year 15%, 2nd Year 12%, 3rd Year 9%, 4th Year 7%, etc. If you received a bonus when you first put your money into that annuity, you might lose that, too. Do the math. Insurance companies' compliance departments have guidelines which clearly frown on replacing a recent annuity. Of course, there are exceptions. If you feel pressured, you might want to question your agent's ethics.

We bought a home and now we're getting a lot of mail saying we should buy

mortgage protection insurance. How's that different from life insurance?

Mortgage protection insurance often times has a decreasing benefit to supposedly coincide with a decreasing mortgage balance. Some mortgage insurance is really an accident policy. I would recommend enough life insurance to give the beneficiary(-ies) the option of paying off the mortgage if that is determined to be the best use of the funds. On the other hand, if you have a strong family history of critical illnesses (heart attack, cancer, etc.) then you might want to consider a Critical Illness insurance policy or an annuity which accelerates benefits for critical illness.

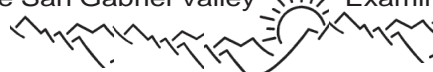

Gov. Brown and Democrat Affordable Housing Solutions

Watching a local council meeting this week I found out about new legislation that pre-emptly once again local control of zoning issues in the area of housing development and at the same time has the impact of potential property tax losses to our cities. More at issue for me is the kind of community the average citizen has chosen to live in that appears to be constantly mandated away by Sacramento politicians who seem to think they know what's best for us always.

I know Republicans and Democrats have philosophical differences and that clearly shows up on party platforms. But when we get down to real life and average citizens, I can't believe all democrats want to live in high-density complexes or cram so called "granny flats" in their backyards rather than have a little open space and greenery or lease out their extra bedroom to Joe Schmoe as is being proposed by San Francisco democrats in Sacramento.

AB 2818, by Assemblyman David Chiu, D-San Francisco, signed off on by Governor Jerry Brown, allows for non-profit Community Land Trusts to purchase property and sell it back to qualified low income persons / families. The only definition I found so far of low-income is \$88,000 a year income for a family of four.

The rationale for this legislation offered up by the democrats writing up this legislation is the shortfall of housing and the high cost of that housing when it is constructed. To remedy that situation, the League of California Cities' analysis says:

AB 2818 requires the county assessor to consider, when valuing real property for property taxation purposes ... imposed on housing units and the land on which the units are situated under a contract that is a 99-year ground lease between a community land trust and the qualified owner ... restrictions [that] serve the public interest to create and preserve the affordability of residential housing for low or moderate income households. This measure takes effect immediately ... and the state will not reimburse local agencies for property tax revenues lost through this measure. I saw the League of California Cities was opposed to this measure.

Community Land Trust Association of West Marin who helped draft and sponsor the legislation is satisfied this will "stabilize communities suffering from wildly escalating property costs". The Land Trust homeowners will only own the improvements on the land (house and other

er buildings) not the land itself according to West Marin Land Trust.

Housing availability, again in the San Francisco area, gets another boost from Governor Jerry Brown who signed off on SB 1069 making "granny units" easier and less expensive to build, and not just in San Francisco but throughout the State of California while usurping local government's zoning and land use authority.

Sen. Bob Wieckowski, D-Fremont, and Los Angeles Councilmember Gil Cedillo, District 1 (and a former Democratic member of both the California State Assembly and Senate) said in Wieckowski's press release, "SB 1069 eases regulatory burdens by eliminating excessive sprinkler requirements, providing several exceptions to parking restrictions, requiring ministerial approval for conversion of an existing structure to an ADU, (Accessory Dwelling Unit) reducing or eliminating water and sewage hook-up fees, and increasing the maximum size of an ADU." Forgotten in the press release was the additional caveat brought up by the San Jose Mercury News - "Local agencies also cannot impose parking rules for certain ADUs, including those located within a half-mile from public transit, or units that are part of an existing primary residence."

One of the arguments at one time for high density units adjacent or near railroad stations was the elimination of vehicles that cause air pollution and traffic because those living in those units were all going to walk out their doors and ride the train to work. It seems, if that is not the case, local government will now, thanks to democrats in Sacramento, be constrained from any parking enforcement due to this new legislation.

In Governor Brown's rush to solve the housing crisis, he also signed off on Assemblyman Tony Thurmond's D-Richmond AB 2406 permitting junior accessory dwelling units that creates small private apartments from spare bedrooms. The rationale for

this legislation Brown signed off on was ... it will create an abundant source of rental housing while making owning a home more affordable by leasing out part of the underutilized space in that residence.

Thurmond's justification for trampling on local zoning says in his press release, "Junior Accessory Dwelling Units convert an existing bedroom to create a housing unit like a studio apartment, which includes doors to the outside as well as a kitchen and counter with running water and sink. These units do not increase the occupant capacity of a home or create greater strain on infrastructure since the permit for the home has already taken into account the occupation of the bedroom." I wonder if the person renting that area will have a car or take a shower?

Reading this and back up materials along with newspaper articles tells me San Francisco, home of Gavin Newsom, former Mayor of San Francisco, now Lt. Governor, revving up for a run for Governor, has a big housing problem it wants to solve overnight. If San Francisco and the state want to bring down housing costs perhaps the place to start would be getting rid of the some of the regulations and hoops developers have to navigate these days that drive the housing costs sky-high. Let's do that across the board rather than creating bad legislation dictating lifestyles for all and laws that usurp local government's zoning authority.

Eliminating sprinklers, water and sewer hook ups for second kitchen units, throwing the door open allowing additional motor vehicles with no guidelines are not affordability issues, but they are health and safety issues that could quickly escalate to hazardous situations.

Again, these democrats from the San Francisco area seem to believe in stripping away tax revenue from local governments to solve their problem and support their agenda --- tax revenue that provides not only essential police and fire service to cities, but quality of life services we've all come to enjoy like libraries, senior centers, youth centers and activities and the list goes on.

One blank spot in all of this, at least for me, makes me ask the questions - Land Trusts established state wide, buy up property, sell back the structures (homes, apartments, condos) to those deemed low or moderate income earners, but keep ownership of the land itself ... after 99 years, who will own all that land? Who will they be and what do they do with all that land?

"TIME JOCKEY" - Desert Training

Camp Young In the fall of 1941, the world was in the middle of a major global conflict. Nazi Germany occupied most of Europe and was expanding their domination to Northern Africa. The Empire of Japan was aggressively invading Southeast Asian countries seeking to expand their empire. By December 1941, the United States had been drawn into World War II after the surprise attack upon Pearl Harbor in the Hawaiian Islands. Winston Churchill asked the United States to help fight the German Army which was threatening to seize the Suez Canal but President Roosevelt knew that the United States did not have any troops which were trained in desert warfare.

In February 1942, the U.S. Army initiated a project to establish a training center for U.S. soldier to learn the fine art of desert warfare. Selected to lead the project was Southern California's own General George S. Patton Jr. who was born on the Benjamin Wilson-George Patton Sr. ranch at Lake Vineyard in the San

Gabriel Township which would later become part of the City of San Marino. Patton's directives were to advance his own tank warfare expertise and to train U.S. soldiers for desert combat. Patton took on the challenge and immediately began looking for a desert site to build a training camp. He surveyed the desert areas of Southern California, Arizona, Nevada and New Mexico before selecting 18,000 square miles of the Mojave Desert as his primary location. Patton established 12 individual camps within the Desert Training Center of the California-Arizona Maneuver Area with the headquarters located at Camp Young at Chiriaco Summit, approximately 25 miles east of Indio. Patton designed the training center utilizing its location to the Metropolitan Water District aqueduct and railroad lines so that he could bring in the necessary supplies and water to support the large number of Army soldiers expected to be stationed at the camp. He wanted to establish a training center which emulated the harshest conditions possible including the rationing

of water to a canteen per day. It may seem like a canteen a day would be enough but with temperatures reaching 130 degrees in the shade, and men training with full maneuvers, it was barely enough to stay alive.

Between April 1942 and April 1944, over 1 million men were trained under severe simulated desert warfare conditions, the largest number of simulated operations in military history. The men who were trained at the center eventually helped the United States and allies win the war but their training also helped each of them to survive and deal with the unforgiving warfare conditions. All that remains of Camp Young is the General Patton Memorial Museum which contains an exquisite collection of World War II artifacts including tanks, jeeps and Patton's own collection of military items. The Museum and training camp is open 7 days a week and is a trip well worth the visit for anyone interested in military history....

ICE (Immigrations and Customs Enforcement) removed a total of 240,255 aliens in FY 2016, a two percent increase over FY 2015. ICE also continues to focus on criminal aliens, as 58 percent of overall ICE removals, including 92 percent of ICE removals initiated in the interior of the country, were of convicted criminals. At the same time, 95 percent of non-criminal removals were apprehended at or near the border or ports of entry.

In 2012 there were over 400,000 arrests during Obama's term. The following years, this was cut in half and many think that Obama was looking to the future election and continued to drop when Hilary Clinton announce her bid for the White House Seat. Some feel this was an attempt to help secure the Hispanic vote for Clinton for the 2016 election.

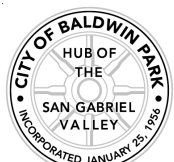

If you ever feel your finances are too stretched to save for retirement, you're not alone—and there could be good news for you. The Saver's Credit—a little-known tax credit made available by the IRS to eligible taxpayers—could make saving for retirement more affordable than you think. It may reduce your federal income taxes when you save for retirement through a qualified retirement plan or an Individual Retirement Account (IRA).



The Saver's Credit—a little-known tax credit made available by the IRS to eligible taxpayers—could make saving for retirement more affordable than many people realize.

"The Saver's Credit is a fantastic tax credit because it pays you to save for retirement. It offers eligible workers an added incentive to save for retirement on top of the benefits of tax-deferred savings when they contribute to a 401(k), 403(b) or IRA," says Catherine Collinson, president of non-profit Transamerica Center for Retirement Studies®.

Here's how it works:

1. Check Your Eligibility

Depending on your filing status and income level, you may qualify for a nonrefundable credit of up to \$1,000 (or \$2,000 if filing jointly) on your federal income taxes for that year when you contribute to a 401(k), 403(b) or similar retirement plan, IRA or myRA.

Single filers with an Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) of up to \$30,750 in 2016 or \$31,000 in 2017 are eligible. For the head of a household, the AGI limit is \$46,125 in 2016 or \$46,500 in 2017. For those who are married and file a joint return, the AGI limit is \$61,500 in 2016 or \$62,000 in 2017.

You must be 18 years old or older by January 1 and cannot be a full-time student or be claimed as a dependent on another person's tax return. If you fit within these parameters, the Saver's Credit may be for you.

2. Save for Retirement

Save for retirement in your employer's retirement plan, if offered, or in an IRA. In general, for every dollar you contribute to a qualified retirement plan or IRA (up to the lesser of the limits permitted by an employer-sponsored plan or the IRS), you defer that amount from your current overall taxable income on your federal tax returns—and you may also qualify for the Saver's Credit.

3. File Your Tax Return and Claim the Credit

When you prepare your federal tax returns, you can claim your Saver's Credit by subtracting this tax credit from your federal income taxes owed.

Workers who are eligible to claim the Saver's Credit are also eligible to take advantage of IRS' Free File program for taxpayers with an AGI of \$64,000 or less. Twelve commercial software companies make their tax preparation software available for free through the Free File program at

www.irs.gov/FreeFile.

If you are using tax preparation software, including those offered through IRS' Free File program at www.irs.gov, use Form 1040, Form 1040A or Form 1040NR. If your software has an interview process, be sure to answer questions about the Saver's Credit, also referred to as the Retirement Savings Contributions Credit and/or Credit for Qualified Retirement Savings Contributions.

If you are preparing your tax returns manually, complete Form 8880, the Credit for Qualified Retirement Savings Contributions, to determine your exact credit rate and amount. Then transfer the amount to the designated line on Form 1040, Form 1040A or Form 1040NR.

If you are using a professional tax preparer, be sure to ask about the Saver's Credit.

Consider having any refund you receive directly deposited to an IRA to further boost your retirement savings.

Note that the Saver's Credit is not available with Form 1040EZ.

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Senator Portantino Introduces Legislation Giving County Assessor and Caltrans the Tools Necessary to Help Keep 710 Properties Affordable

SACRAMENTO – Senator Anthony J. Portantino introduced SB 275 that gives the Los Angeles County Assessor's Office the ability to assess single-family homes within the 710 corridor appropriately. Keeping properties affordable in the 710 corridor has been the goal and intent of the state legislature since passing the Roberti Bill in 1979.

The Roberti Bill planned and outlined the process for the disposition of the 710 properties acquired by Caltrans. The Bill directed the Department of Transportation to sell surplus residential properties along SR 710 in a manner that would preserve, upgrade, and expand the supply of housing available in the region. It also put an emphasis on making those homes and properties affordable. The af-

fordable housing crisis continues to be one of California's biggest issues and the disposition of the Caltrans homes has finally arrived. Legislation is now needed to help the Los Angeles County Assessor meet the spirit and intent of Roberti.

"This legislation will allow many of the residents who live in the SR 710 corridor to purchase property with an assessed valuation that would not price them out of that purchase," stated Portantino. "As the 710 surface freeway and tunnel's days are numbered it is imperative that we enact practical legislation to help facilitate the proper disposition of the Caltrans homes and properties. I am very grateful to the Los Angeles County Assessor's office for working collaboratively on this important fix for the residents in my district," concluded Portantino.

It was always intended that many of the 710 homes and properties would go to existing tenants and be affordable at the time of purchase. As the affordable housing crisis continues to be one of Los Angeles' biggest issues, this bill has taken on even more importance.

"Assisting people who will purchase 710 corridor homes by valuing the properties for affordability is the right thing to do," said Jeffrey Prang, Los Angeles County Assessor. "I support Senator Portantino's efforts to resolve the long-standing concern about residential properties in the path of the former 710 Freeway."

Assessor Prang emphasized that the clear direction provided in Senator Portantino's legislation to assist the residents of the area by making the homes as affordable as possible.

Child Seat Safety Inspection Day

SAN GABRIEL - The San Gabriel Police Department will be conducting a child seat safety inspection day on Saturday, **February 18** from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., in the rear parking lot of the San Gabriel Police Department located at 625 South Del Mar Avenue.

The San Gabriel Police Department maintains three Certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians who will provide free, hands-on, car seat education and inspections during the event. The goal is to make sure all parents and caregivers are correctly securing all children in the right car restraint (rear-facing car seat, forward-facing car seat, booster seat or seat belt) for their ages and sizes.

Car seats, booster seats and seat belts save lives and offer the best protection for children in crashes and work best when used correctly! Car crashes are a leading cause of death for children 1 to 13 years old. During the 5-year period from 2007 to 2011, 3,661 children were killed in car crashes. In addition, an estimated 634,000 children were injured, more than the population of Boston, Massachusetts. Based on U.S. Department of Transportation, National Highway Transportation Safety Administration (NHTSA) crash data in 2011, on average, nearly 2 children under 13 were killed and 338 were injured every day while riding in cars, SUVs, pickups and vans. In 2011, over one third of children killed in car crashes were not in car seats or wearing seat belts.

A simple car seat check is critical to the safety of our most precious resource, our children. Make plans to attend the child seat safety check.

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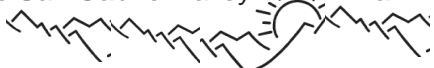
