NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Glendora City Council will hold a public hearing in the City Council Chambers of City Hall, 116 E. Foothill Boulevard, Glendora, California, on Tuesday, March 13, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. to receive and consider public input on needs and resources relative to the Five-Year (2018-2023) Consolidated Plan, One-Year Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2018-2019, and the Analysis of Impediments (AI) to Fair Housing Choice.

PUBLIC HEARING MEETING LOCATION AND DATE

The City of Glendora is requesting public input on its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program at 7:00 P.M., at its March 13, 2018 City Council meeting. The draft Consolidated Plan, Annual Action Plan, and Analysis of Impediments documents will be available on March 22, 2018 for a 30-day public review, ending April 23, 2018. A second public hearing will be held on April 24, 2018 to approve submittal of the Plans to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

In compliance with the American with Disabilities Act, if you need special assistance to participate in the meeting, please contact the City of Glendora's City Clerk's Office at (626) 914-8210. Notification 48 hours prior to the March 13, 2018 City Council meeting will enable the City to make reasonable arrangements to ensure accessibility to the meeting.

BACKGROUND

Consolidated Plan: Every five years, the CDBG program requires that the City adopt a "Consolidated Plan," which establishes the goals and objectives of the City's CDBG program. During the development of this 2018-2023 Consolidated Plan, which forms the basis for establishing objectives and outcomes in the Strategic Plan and five (5) subsequent Annual Action Plans, the following priority needs and objectives were established:

- 1. Infrastructure and Public Facilities: Improve and expand infrastructure and public facilities that benefit low- and moderate-income neighborhoods and residents.
2. Economic and Human Development: Provide for the economic development needs of low- and moderate- income persons and neighborhood target areas.
3. Fair Housing: Promote fair and equal housing choice for all persons.
4. Administration and Planning: Provide for administration and planning activities to carry out actions that address identified needs in the Consolidated Plan.

These established Priority Needs form the basis for allocating investments geographically within the City during the next five-year period and are a result of various community outreach efforts and consultation meetings developed under the Citizen Participation process.

Annual Action Plan: The Annual Action Plan is part of the Five-Year Consolidated Plan and serves as the City's application for funding from HUD. The City of Glendora will receive an allocation of approximately \$245,502 of CDBG funds for FY 2018-2019. As the Federal Budget has not been approved at this time and the City must meet certain statutory deadlines in submitting its annual Action Plan and allowing for citizen participation, staff has developed this allocation amount based on last year's allocation. Once the official allocation for Glendora is released from HUD, staff will revise the budget as needed and present the final figures at the April 24, 2018 meeting for the adoption of both the Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan.

The CDBG funding may be allocated to the following types of eligible projects:

- 1. Acquisition: by purchase, long-term lease, and donation of real property for an eligible public purpose.
2. Disposition: of real property acquired under the CDBG Program.
3. Construction and Rehabilitation: of certain publicly owned facilities, such as (a) senior citizen centers; (b) parks and playgrounds; (c) community centers; (d) fire protection facilities and equipment; (e) sidewalks and street improvements; (f) water and sewer systems.
4. Rehabilitation of publicly and privately owned housing: for low- and moderate-income households.
5. Public Services: which are new or expanding, and directed toward meeting employment, crime prevention, child care, drug abuse prevention, homeless assistance, or other community service needs.
6. Removal of Architectural Barriers: that restricts the mobility and accessibility of elderly or handicapped persons to publicly owned and privately owned buildings, facilities, and improvements.
7. Special Economic Development Activities: that provide grants, loan guarantees and other forms of necessary or appropriate support to private "for profit" businesses to provide increasing employment opportunities and other public benefit.

While funding amounts are somewhat flexible, there are statutory limitations that restrict the amount of funding for Planning and Administration costs to not more than 20 percent of the annual grant allocation and limit public services to 15 percent of the annual grant allocation. The final allocations will be determined once HUD releases their budget.

Based on the limited amount of resources available to the City, statutory restrictions, and the Priority Needs established, staff recommendations for the FY 2018-2019 CDBG One-Year Annual Action Plan are as follows:

Analysis of Impediments (AI) to Fair Housing Choice: The AI presents a demographic profile of Glendora, assesses the extent of housing needs of its residents, and evaluates the availability of a range of housing choices for all. This report also analyzes the conditions in the private market and public sector that may limit the range of housing choices or impede a person's access to housing. The AI includes the following key sections:

- Community Outreach - Discusses the outreach efforts undertaken for the development of the AI.
Community Profile - Presents the demographic, housing, and income characteristics in the City of Glendora.
Lending Practices - Assesses the access to financing for different groups.
Public Policies - Analyzes various public policies and actions that may impede fair housing within the City.
Current Fair Housing Profile - Evaluates existing public and private programs, services, practices, and activities that assist in providing fair housing in the City.
Progress Since Previous AI - Assesses the progress the City has made since the preparation of the previous AI.
Fair Housing Action Plan - Summarizes the findings regarding fair housing issues in Glendora and provides recommendations for furthering fair housing practices.

PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT PERIOD

All interested persons are invited to the Public Hearing to comment on the City's CDBG program, the Consolidated Plan priorities, Action Plan, and AI. In addition, written comments may be submitted to the City prior to the public hearing and during the 30-day public comment period.

Comments from the public hearing and those submitted to staff during the comment period will be addressed in the final version of the Plans submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Comments and questions regarding the Plans can be addressed to:

The Wall That Heals Is Coming To San Dimas On March 22 Through March 25

Vietnam Veterans Memorial Replica Wall and Mobile Education Center spreads healing legacy of The Wall and educates about the impact of the Vietnam War

WASHINGTON, D.C. - The Wall That Heals, a replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, along with a mobile Education Center, is coming to San Dimas, California on March 22 through March 25, 2018 at Lone Hill Middle School, 700 S. Lone Hill, San Dimas and will be open 24 hours a day and free to the public. The Wall That Heals honors the more than three million Americans who served in the U.S. Armed forces in the Vietnam War and it bears the names of the more than 58,000 men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice in Vietnam.

The Vietnam Veterans Memorial is one of the most visited memorials in our nation's capital, with more than 5.3 million visitors each year. However, many Americans have not been able to visit what has become known to many as "The Wall." "We hope it provides an opportunity for healing and an educational experience for the whole community on the impact of the Vietnam War on America."

More than 250,000 people visited The Wall That Heals in 2016. Since its debut in 1996, the exhibit has been on display in nearly 500 U.S. communities in addition to an April 1999 tour of the Four Provinces of Ireland and a visit to Canada

in 2005. Hosting The Wall That Heals provides a community with a multi-day experience that includes an educational experience for local schools and organizations on the history of the Vietnam era and The Wall. The exhibit includes The Wall replica and a mobile Education Center comprised of: digital displays of photos of service members whose names are on The Wall; letters and memorabilia representative of items left at The Wall in D.C.; a map of Vietnam and a chronological overview of the Vietnam War. About the half-scale replica

The replica Wall is approximately 250 feet in length, and like the original Memorial is erected in a chevron-shape. The replica is constructed of powder-coated aluminum, supported by an aluminum frame, and is made up of 24 individual panels, each containing six columns of names.

The names on The Wall That Heals replicate the names on The Wall in Washington, D.C. As on The Wall, the names are listed alphabetically by day of casualty. Beginning at the center/apex, the names start on the East Wall (right-hand side) working their way

out to the end of that wing, picking up again at the far end of the West Wall (left-hand side) and working their way back in to the center/apex. Thus, the beginning and ending of the conflict are joined at the center, signifying an epoch in American history.

The Wall That Heals is transported from community to community by a trailer with cases built into its sides, allowing it to serve as a mobile Education Center that tells the story of the Vietnam War, The Wall and the divisive era in American history.
