# The Azusa Rotary Foundation Presents The First Azusa Field Of Glory

**AZUSA-** The Azusa Rotary Foundation and the Azusa Rotary Club, in conjunction with many valued partners in the City of Azusa are proud to announce, an inspirational and patriotic display of hundreds of U.S. flags on the Azusa City Hall front lawn.

The flag display will run from November 5 to November 12th, and will be up during the annual Azusa Veteran's Day event on Friday, November 11 at 11:00 a.m. and remain up all day Saturday. Flags are being sold for \$35 each, and if desired may be claimed when the Field of Glory is taken down on Sunday, November 13th. Poles and ground stakes are available for an additional \$15. All parts of the display are made in the U.S.A.

Flags are sold to honor veterans, servicepersons, first responders, personal heroes, or any loved ones. The Rotary or its volunteers will personalize a tag that will be attached to each flag listing the Donor, the Honoree, and if desired, some information about the Honoree. There is a site map showing visitors where to find individual flags in the Field, and the Field of Glory will be illuminated at night in accordance

The Opening Ceremony for the Field of Glory flag display took place on Saturday, November 5 at 10:00 a.m. in front of Azusa's City Hall front lawn surrounded by over 600 flags. Funds raised from the event will be used to help fund and benefit Service Person Family Support, Veterans' Support and Recognition, and local Youth Leadership Programs. Navy Lt. and Azusa Councilman Uriel Macias was the Master of Ceremonies. He started the ceremony by asking for the Presentation of Colors by the Azusa

VFW 8070 Color Guard, the singing of the National Anthem by Anna Aguilar and the Pledge of Allegiance by SM3 Les Bartholomew, US Navy.

Following the introduction of Dignitaries, Azusa Mayor Joe Rocha and Councilman Robert Gonzales delivered welcome remarks followed by Mercedes Castro representing the Canyon City Foundation who provided via a grant as seed funding to start the annual Field of Glory. With the Keynote Speaker and 2016 Veteran of the Year was Bob "Mr. Inspiration" Wieland, an Army Veteran from West Covina. Bob Wieland was born and raised in Greenfield, Wisconsin, where he was an all-star athlete on his way to a professional baseball career.

During his service for his country in the Vietnam War, his life was forever changed. While attempting to rescue a fallen comrade, Bob stepped on and detonated an 88mm mortar

round. His legs were blown off instantly. Bob was pronounced "dead on arrival" at the hospital, however God had another plan.

Bob chose to focus on the victories. "I lost my legs, not my heart." After leaving rehab in record time, Bob began to rebuild his life, "One Step at a Time." He enrolled at California State University, Los Angeles majoring in physical education with a specialization in Exercise Physiology. He was hired by the Green Bay Packers as their

strength and motivation coach. He became a nationally known speaker and still accepts invitations to share his story all over the world.

As a member of the President's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports, Bob's numerous honors include People Magazine's "One of the Six Most Amazing Americans of the Past 20 Years," the NFL's "Most Courageous Man in America;" and the prestigious Victor Award.

Bob's personal accomplish-

ments include his "Walk Across America" which took him an astounding 3 years, 8 months and 6 days. He's the only double amputee to complete the Ironman Triathlon in Kona, Hawaii; and a former world record holder in the bench press with a best lift of 507 pounds. Bob competed in the New York City Marathon, the Marine Corps Marathon and the Los Angeles Marathon. Bob has received the National Veteran of the Year Award, the California Disabled American Veterans Award and the Wisconsin Outstanding Disabled American

Veteran Award. Bob is passionate about motivating others to continue "to give just a measure more of themselves."

As the keynote speaker, he punctuated his story with humor and sadness.

Senator Hernandez recognized the other recipients from all over the East San Gabriel Valley in his district. They each received their recognition and addressed the packed crowd at the VFW Post.

If you note the names on the list, Jorge V. Rosales is one of the Examiner's Contributing Writers. Special congratulations to him and all the other recipients.

## Coincidence? I Think Not!

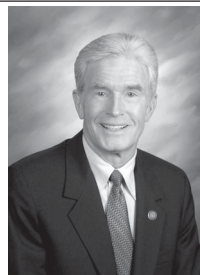
As the divisiveness continues bubbling to the surface and the finger pointing from each presidential candidate continues, I for one hope we can eventually return to more historically normal concerns with less fears about our declining Country. For a brief breath of fresh air, I would like to talk about Honest Abe, one of our greatest presidents.

In an even stranger twist of fate, just months before Booth shot Lincoln, the President's son, Robert Todd Lincoln, fell from a train platform in Jersey City. He was pulled from under a slow-moving train before any harm ensued. His rescuer was the well-known actor Edwin Booth, the brother of John Wilkes Booth; so the son of a president was rescued by the brother of his assassin.

Even though this is a mind-twisting overlap of history, I would imagine that many of you who read it may feel somewhat blasé about it, not because it's

uninteresting, but because you've either heard it before or you already know the world is filled with bizarre twists. The rule of thumb on Wall Street is this: If you are feeling that way, everyone else is feeling that way. On Wall Street, as emotional reactions come closer to exuberance or fear, so did everyone else's and thus the market came closer to its highs or lows. While this sounds unscientific, studies are now being done to test the possibilities of a human collective consciousness. The term used on Wall Street is "The Herd" response.

The reason I bring this up is because I can tell you how I felt when I discovered Lincoln's coincidences, and how I currently feel. I was interested by what I saw but it was darkly overshadowed by other thoughts and feelings. I felt (and still feel) tired of this election cycle and want it over with. I am tired of emails and tax-returns, groping's and Wiki leaks. There is a negativity, divisiveness, and a moral low unprecedented in any prior presidential election of our collective lifetimes. This is a fact. I am frustrated with the fear-mongering in the media in regards to Russia and the geopolitical environment. I am worn out with Julian Assange's saga in the Ecuadorian embassy. Mosul, Yemen, Aleppo, Putin, Trump, Hillary, classified secret thefts, accusers, and on and on. The news media is a bona fide three-ring circus and ped-

dler of ideological propaganda. Yet it's the biggest show in town. I believe that this all translates to what can be witnessed in today's market, and I suspect the way I feel is the way a lot of other people feel. I am tired with the market's indecisiveness and want some clear direction. The uncertainty hanging over this market reflects a directionless nation.

The S&P 500 has been in a fairly tight, range-bound pattern. Since July 8th, when the index vaulted and stayed above 2100, we have been in a 2.96% trading range. The 50-day moving average on the VIX is a low 13.83. The market is essentially flat. Earnings have been moderately positive, but some argue that with a low bar of expectations, it's easier to delight. What we have seen is a sideways grinding of the market and of nerves.

We are in the home stretch of the ugliest election of our lifetime resolving itself. But the picture abroad is not necessarily rosy, with military offensives in Mosul, military action in Yemen, Aleppo still under siege, and Russia/U.S. tensions bubbling - not to mention Brexit's repercussions and Europe's and Asia's central bank self-serving policies.

Sure, several U.S. companies are beating earnings expectations, but the big picture is clear: Uncertainty looms and it looks as though we're a house divided under the surface of the S&P 500. In an appropriate quote to both the election and the market, the great Abraham Lincoln said, "A house divided against itself cannot stand." I bet many other people feel the same as I do: if only he were running for President...

## Your Money - Ask Julia

*My annuity (IRA) contract says I would have to pay a penalty if I take the money out too soon. I turn 70 next year, so I'll need to start taking Required Minimum Distributions. Is there a way to do that without a penalty?*

Even though the annuity contract states there's an early withdrawal penalty, it is waived for RMD.

*I have a lump sum of money from a CD. Is there an investment that is safe, and that will give me lifetime income right away?*

An immediate annuity would give you exactly what you are looking for - safety and immediate income. The insurance company gives you choices for payout: for a fixed period of time, for the rest of your lifetime, or for the rest of your and your spouse's life, and more.

*We have really good credit and we rent an apartment. I want to buy a small home or condo, but my husband doesn't think we can afford to make this change. Do you think we could afford to buy?*

Either get the facts and present them to your husband, or let your husband know that you'd like to sit down with a professional and figure out whether or not you could afford to purchase instead of continuing to rent. He'll probably react in one of two ways - agree or disagree. If he agrees, act before he changes his mind. If he disagrees, he might have another reason.

*Is a MyRA a good investment?*

This Obama-created way to invest went into effect in January of 2015. From my research so far, it has its pro's and con's, and some unknowns. Basically it

is very similar to a Roth IRA - you invest money after you've paid taxes, then it grows, and you can take the money out income-tax free. If you exceed the income caps, you cannot get a MyRA. There is a \$25 minimum to open a MyRA account. You pay no fees. You are limited to contributing up to \$5,500 a year / \$6,500 if age 50-plus (the annual limit for all your IRA's combined). You will be required to roll the balance into a regular, private IRA once it reaches \$15,000. Your principal (the amount of money you put in) is guaranteed (backed by low interest rate U.S. Savings Bonds), and the earnings are not guaranteed. There's no penalty for emergency-early withdrawal of the money you put in, but there is a 10-percent penalty for early withdrawal (before age 59 1/2) of the earnings. Interest earned is variable. Once you roll the money out of your MyRA, you cannot open another MyRA account.

A MyRA account might be a good way for young, low-to-mid-level income workers to start saving.

*What is this secret, tax-free method of investing that I've read "Washington insiders" (Senators, Congressmen, etc.),*

*and the very wealthy, are using to save for retirement? Can I get it?*

You've seen the hype, reported as a much better retirement account than a 401(k) or IRA. It's referred to as a 702(j), or 7702 (IRS code that regulates life insurance contracts). But, these life insurance policies are not like the old whole-life or universal life insurance policies. Today there are permanent life insurance policies which offer much more than the death benefit. The cash value component of these policies can be equity-indexed (similar to many of today's annuities), with company-backed guarantees to protect your funds. These policies have much more transparency, allowing you to choose between several equity indices, and several crediting methods. Basically, you pay for insurance, plus you fund the policy with additional funds. If used as a part of your retirement plan, you could later 'borrow' from that cash value component during your retirement years. Loans are not taxed. Typically, death benefits from a life insurance policy are not taxed. Getting one of these policies is like getting any other life insurance coverage.

## eCigarette Sellers Required to Register for Cigarette and Tobacco Products Retailer Licenses

**SACRAMENTO** - Starting on January 1, 2017, sellers of electronic cigarettes (eCigarettes), vaping devices, and other related products will be required to obtain a Cigarette and Tobacco Products Retailer's License from the California State Board of Equalization (BOE). This license must be obtained prior to making retail sales of these products to consumers. It will cost \$265 for a 12-month period, and must be renewed annually at this cost.

In accordance with Senate Bill x2 5, products requiring licensing will now include: any product containing, made, or derived from nicotine; any electronic

smoking or vaping device that delivers nicotine or other vaporized liquids to the person inhaling from the device; and any component, part, or accessory, even if it's sold separately.

For example, selling eCigarettes, vaping tanks or mods, atomizers, and e-juice or e-liquid at a retail store will require a business to obtain a Cigarette and Tobacco Products Retailer's License. However, these products are not subject to excise taxes imposed by the Cigarette and Tobacco Products Tax Law, and retailers will not be required to maintain purchase invoices or obtain these products from a BOE licensed cigarette or tobac-

co products distributor or wholesaler. This licensing requirement does not apply to cannabis-related vaping devices that are sold in properly licensed cannabis dispensaries.

Sellers of eCigarettes, vaping devices and other related products should also have a California Seller's Permit. Retailers can register for the Cigarette and Tobacco Products Retailer's License online at [www.boe.ca.gov](http://www.boe.ca.gov).

Beginning January 1, 2017, anyone found selling or gifting any of these products without obtaining a valid license is in violation of the law and subject to a misdemeanor citation and seizure of inventory. Products seized are deemed forfeited and cannot be returned by law.

## Drips and Puddles

Those annoying under the car drips can leave your driveway and garage floor a mess...in fact everywhere you park becomes a victim to this mess. They are also a sign that something is wrong and needs to be taken care of. The only drip you don't need to be concerned with is the condensation from your air conditioner. Everything else is a signal that there is a problem. The small drips are giving you fair warning that if ignored, serious prob-

- A reddish brown drip may mean one of three things; leaking transmission, over tightened pan gasket or a leaking front seal.
- A green or orange-red drip suggests a cooling system problem such as leaking hose or radiator.
- A brown to brownish-black drip that is thick in consistency is more than likely engine oil. This is not a huge problem if it

is slight but when it grows to puddle size it is a sign of something serious and if not kept under control could mean severe engine trouble.

- A leak that looks like tea and feels oily is brake fluid. This type of drip or leak is always serious!

If you notice a puddle three inches or larger under your car don't ignore it. Get it to the professionals as soon as possible. A puddle between one and two inches isn't as serious...yet...unless it is brake fluid. Don't put off having it looked at too long though...it could become a much more serious problem.
